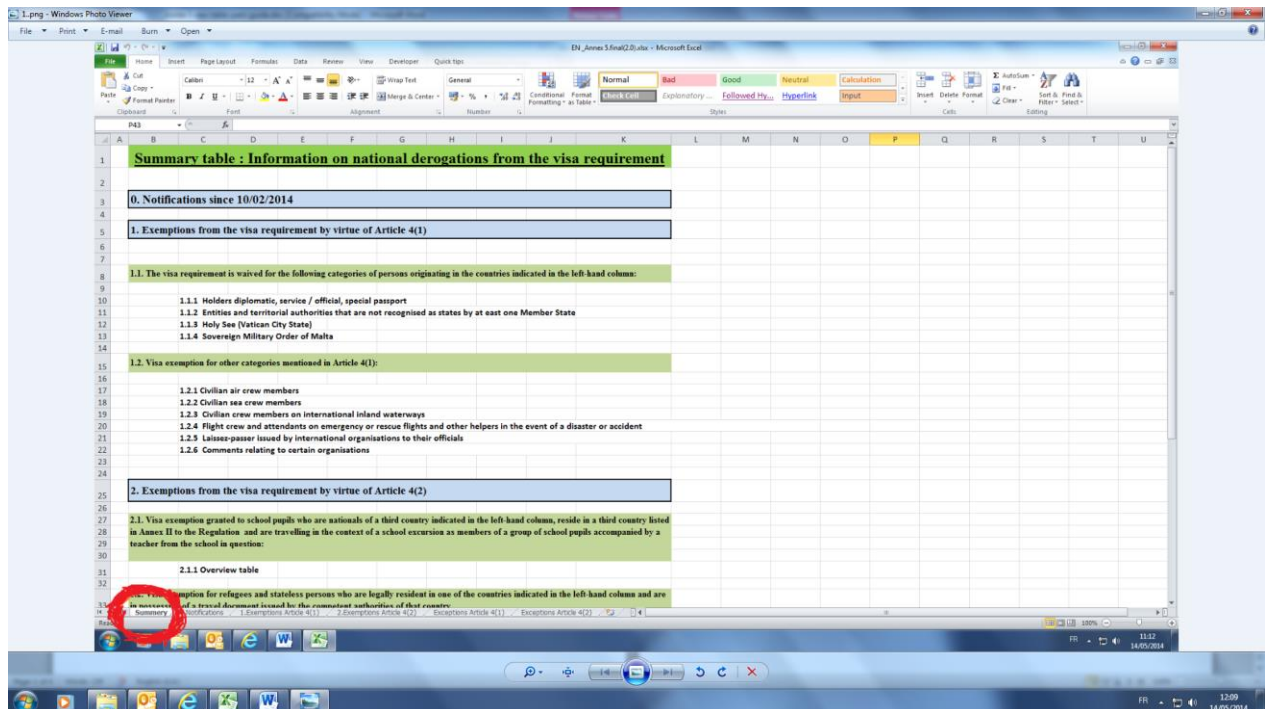


Annex 5 of the Visa Code handbook : Users guide

1. Click on Tab one: Summery

There are five worksheets in the Annex 5 Excel file. The tabs at the bottom of a worksheet tell you the name of the worksheets: Summery / Notifications / 1.Exemptions Article 4(1) / etc. Switching between worksheets can be done by clicking on the tab of the sheet you wish to access.

Click on the first tab "Summery" after having opened the document. This worksheet acts as a Table of Contents displaying the, chapter titles and section titles of the Annex 5.



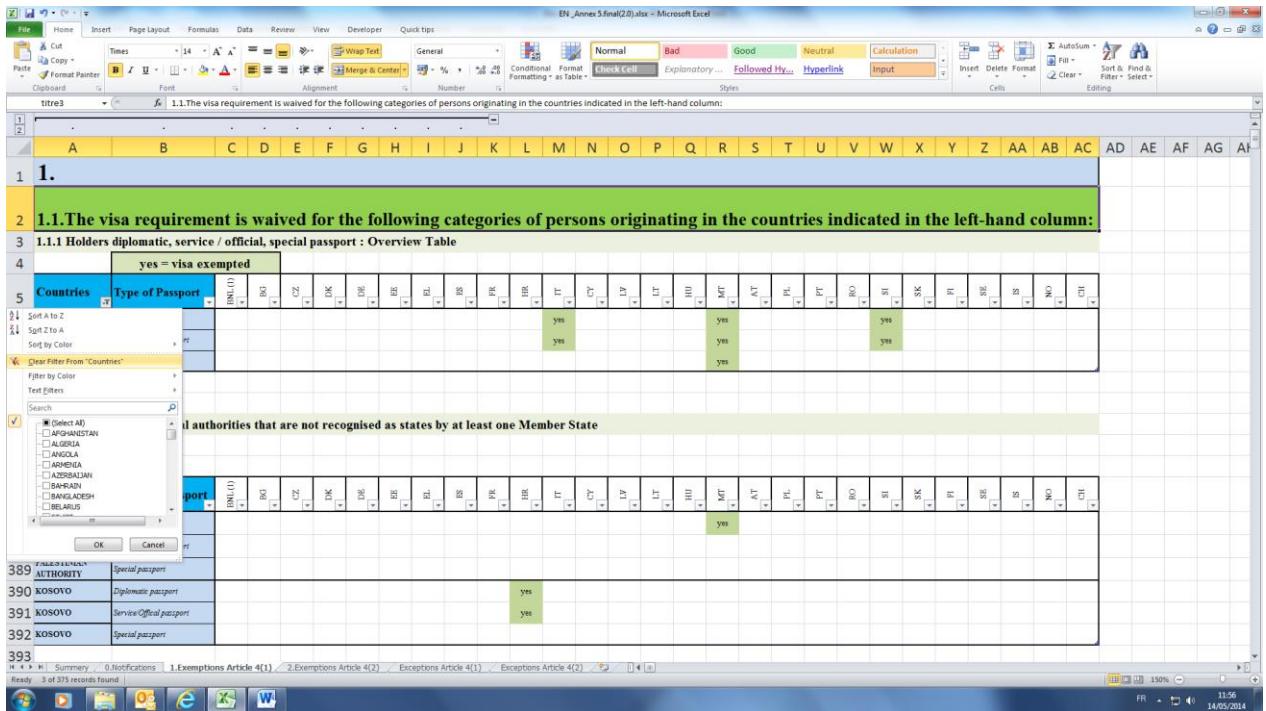
2. Select the title

You can select a single title by clicking on it. Each cell contains a HYPERLINK function: Excel will display the contents of the title which is stored under a tab sheet.

Example: click on 1.1.1 Holders diplomatic, service / official, special passport. You will be jumped to a specific area in the tab 1. Exemption Article 4.1.

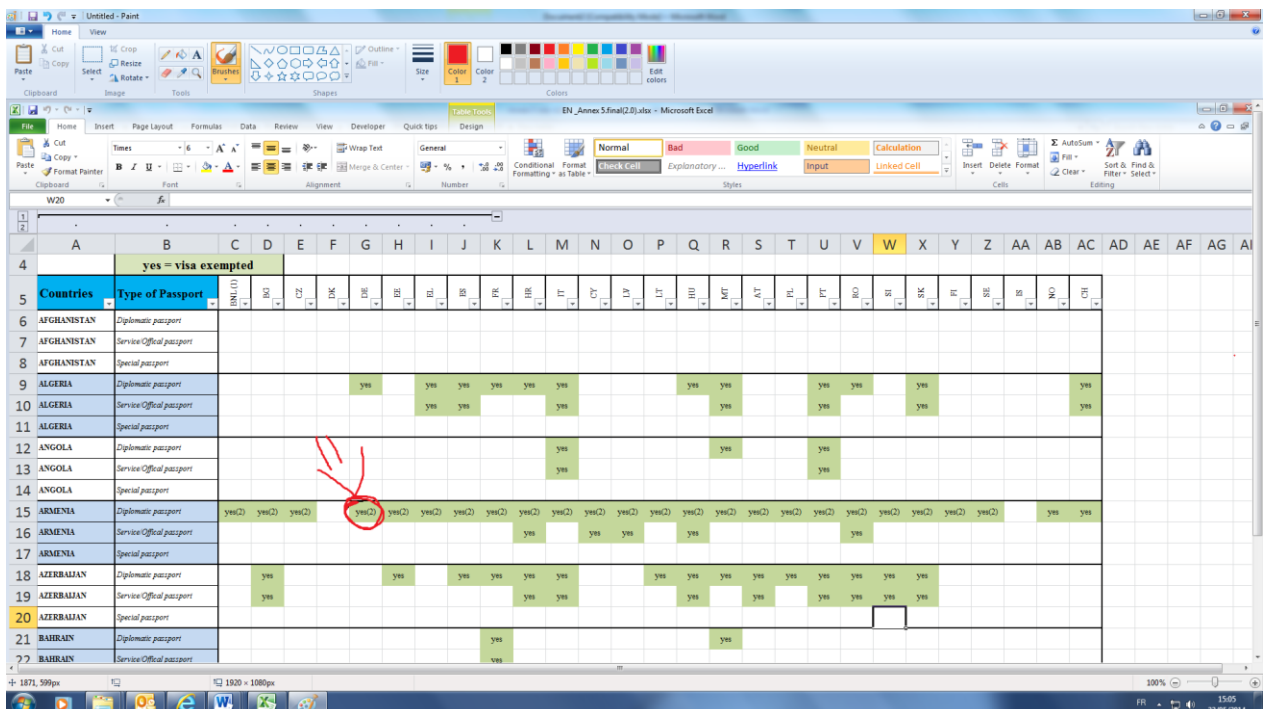
4. To clear a filter:

Click the drop-down arrow in the column from which you want to clear the filter. The filter will be cleared from the column. The data that was previously hidden will be on display once again.



5. How to see comments/footnotes

Click on the cell with a number. You will be redirected to the comment.

1. Exemptions from the visa requirement by virtue of Article 4(1)

1.1. The visa requirement is waived for the following categories of persons originating in the countries indicated in the left-hand column:

- 1.1.1 Holders diplomatic, service / official, special passport
- 1.1.2 Entities and territorial authorities that are not recognised as states by at least one Member State
- 1.1.3 Holy See (Vatican City State)
- 1.1.4 Sovereign Military Order of Malta

1.2. Visa exemption for other categories mentioned in Article 4(1):

- 1.2.1 Civilian air crew members
- 1.2.2 Civilian sea crew members
- 1.2.3 Civilian crew members on international inland waterways
- 1.2.4 Flight crew and attendants on emergency or rescue flights and other helpers in the event of a disaster or accident
- 1.2.5 Laissez-passer issued by international organisations to their officials
- 1.2.6 Comments relating to certain organisations

2. Exemptions from the visa requirement by virtue of Article 4(2)

2.1. Visa exemption granted to school pupils who are nationals of a third country indicated in the left-hand column, reside in a third country listed in Annex II to the Regulation and are travelling in the context of a school excursion as members of a group of school pupils accompanied by a teacher from the school in question:
